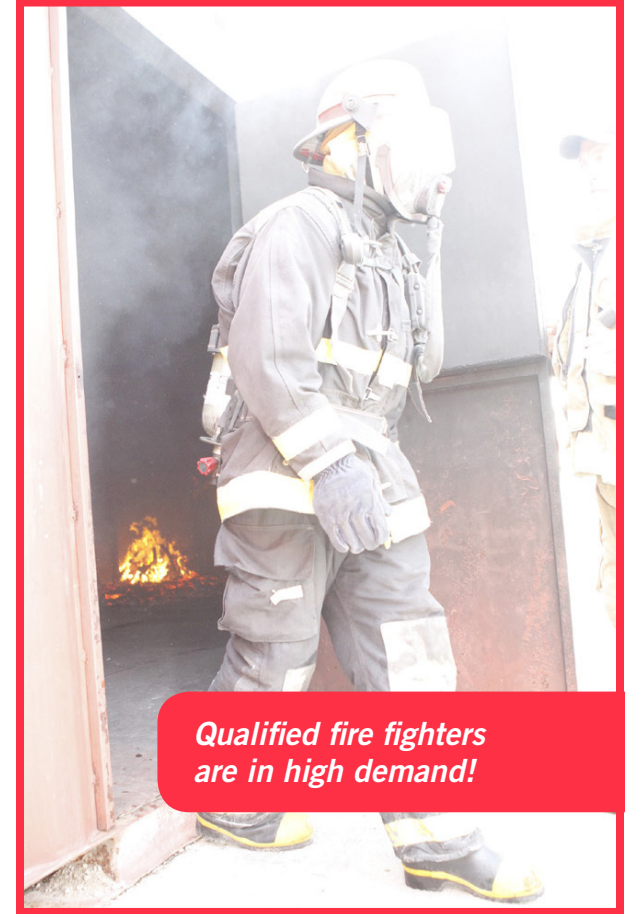
FIRE FIGHTER CERTIFICATION

Fire Fighter 1 (FIRE112)

Basic Fire Protection **10 credit hours**

Course Description

This course introduces basic fire suppression techniques, fire prevention procedures, and skill development.

Fire Fighter 1 is the first of two 15-week courses, which together make up the equivalent of the Fire Academy, and is offered for students who prefer to attend on a part-time basis.

Fire Fighter 2 (FIRE119)

Advanced Fire Suppression **10 credit hours**

Course Description

This course introduces advanced fire suppression techniques, fire prevention procedures, and skill development.

Fire Fighter 2 is the second of two 15-week courses, which together make up the equivalent of the Fire Academy, and is offered for students who prefer to attend on a part-time basis.

Prerequisite: FIRE112 with a grade of 2.0 or higher.
